- **Development Strategy & Execution:** Work collaboratively with the Executive Director, Communications Coordinator, and Board of Directors to implement and evaluate TSI's fundraising strategy.
- **Donor Cultivation & Stewardship:** Identify, cultivate, and solicit major gifts and grants from individuals, corporations, and foundations. Manage a portfolio of active and prospective donors in collaboration with the Executive Director.
- **Grant Management:** Oversee all aspects of grant seeking, including research, proposal writing, reporting, and relationship-building with funders.
- **Database & Fundraising Systems:** Maintain and optimize TSI's fundraising and communications database using Network for Good, ensuring accuracy and efficiency.
- **Donor Engagement & Reporting:** Work with the Communications Coordinator and Evaluation Specialist to develop impactful donor reports (trimester, biannual, and annual).
- **Fundraising Communications & Materials:** Collaborate on the creation of compelling promotional materials, including brochures, videos, banners, and newsletters.
- **Website & Digital Fundraising:** Ensure TSI's website effectively communicates impact and provides an accessible platform for donor engagement and giving.
- Organizational Fundraising Culture: Foster a culture of fundraising within TSI, engaging and training staff and Board members.
- **Performance Tracking & Impact Assessment:** Collaborate with the Evaluation team to monitor key performance indicators, analyze data, and present findings.
